## NOTES ON USING THIS CALENDAR

1. Jewish days begin the evening before, so the Sabbath, which is on Saturdays, begins at sundown on Friday nights; holidays likewise begin the evening before the date shown. Therefore, candle lighting time appears in the upper right-hand corner for the evening before (i.e., Friday). Havdalah (end of Sabbath/holiday) times are in the upper right-hand corner of the actual day (i.e., Saturday).
2. Regular weekly readings, according to the annual Torah cycle, are listed in the column next to each month's calendar. If nothing is listed for a given Saturday, it means it is also a holiday whose special reading preempts the regular weekly parsha. Holiday readings are listed on pages 6 and 7 for 5783, and on page 53 for 5784.
3. Some Saturdays have special names, such as Shabbat Nachamu. Sometimes the name comes from a special maftir or haftarah, read after the weekly parsha. Other times, the name reflects the regular haftarah or time of year, in which case it appears in parentheses.

***Please note: Candle lighting times on the monthly calendar pages represent the New York City time zone. Times for Miami and Los Angeles are now listed on pages 46-52.***

Baruch Atah Adonai Elohenu melech ha-olam, she-asah nissim lavotaynu, ba-yamim ha-hem, ba-z'man ha-zeh.

Blessed are You, the Eternal our God, Who performed wondrous deeds for our ancestors in days of old, at this season.

*(On the first evening only, add this blessing:)*

Baruch Atah Adonai Elohenu melech ha-olam, she-hecheyanu, v'kiyimanu, v'higi-anu, la-z'man hazeh.

Blessed are You the Eternal our God, for giving us life, for sustaining us, and for enabling us to reach this season.
